

Brachyscome- Mauve. Bacopa- White. Ipomea-Bright Ideas Lime. Petunia- Purple, Piccola Hot Pink. Lysimachia.

New to our program, roses require special care but the flowers are easily the most rewarding to see. Planted in a 2-gallon planter and available in light pink, dark pink, and yellow; Patio Roses are the perfect gift for that special someone in your life.

Even if that special someone is you!







- When it is warmer, water on a daily-basis
- To avoid mildew, do not overhead water; keep leaves and flowers dry
- Requires 6+ hours of daily sunlight morning sun is okay
- Using a liquid fertilizer, water roses first, add the liquid fertilizer, then water a little more so fertilizer reaches the roots
- Prefers a well-draining soil and benefit from Mulching during early Spring each year
- Can be kept outside year-round, but needs protection from freezing (roots can be insulated over the Winter/kept indoors)





WHO DOESN'T LIKE FRESH STRAWBERRIES?

These everbearing strawberries will produce fruit all summer long and give you motivation to water everyday.



- Water thoroughly until water runs out the bottom
- Strawberries require full sun
- · Fertilize once a week with a water soluble fertilizer such as Miracle Gro and supplement every 3-4 weeks with our Flower and Veggie 10-15-19 Fertilizer
- Strawberries prefer well draining soil. To maintain and promote growth, be sure to harvest berries promptly
- Place outside when temperatures reach about 10° to 15°



CARE TIPS | **

- Water thoroughly when top of soil is dry
- · Herbs require full sun
- · Fertilize with a balanced fertilizer
- Plant in well-draining soil. To maintain and promote growth, snip/pinch the stems
- Place outside when temperatures reach about 10° to 15°







GROW YOUR OWN VEGGIES THIS SPRING/SUMMER



A great selection of our finest veggies all in a convenient 10-pack.



- · Water thoroughly when top of soil is dry
- · Veggies require full sun
- Fertilize using a balanced fertilizer
- Plant in well-draining soil. Encourage growth by harvesting promptly
- Tomatoes do not like the rain. Move them under a cover or place under a clear plastic
- Place outside when temperatures reach about 10° to 15°

CARE TIPS | 🔅 🖒

- Succulents don't like being over-watered. Let them dry out before watering.
 Sometimes the bathroom may have too much moisture for them to thrive
- Full sunlight is preferred all the time. Rotate succulents every 2 weeks for all to get adequate light
- Fertilize with a balanced fertilizer once in the Spring and once in the Summer
- Succulents prefer porous sandy soil that is well-draining
- Place outside when temperatures reach 15° (they can handle heat very well)



The perfect and easy addition to any garden or container. Featuring vibrant red, pink, and white color options; these are known to be resistant to pests such as deer and rabbits.

EASY TO **GROW GARDEN MUST-HAVE**





- Geraniums need to be wet, but not soggy. Do not let roots sit in water. Water until the water starts running out of the bottom of pot
- Requires 4-6 hours of daily sunlight
- May use a balanced fertilizer every 2-3 weeks
- To maintain & promote growth, pinch off any flowers that have finished blooming
- Assortment prefers well-draining soil
 - Place outside when temperatures reach 10°-15° or indoors if it will freeze over-night

THE GREEN **THUMBS FAVORITE**

A very popular cascading Wave Petunia is a favorite when creating your own basket or container. They come in 3 beautiful eye-catching colors of purple, white, and pink.
