Patio Rose

Roses require special care but the flowers are easily the most rewarding to see. Planted in a 2gallon planter and available in light pink, dark pink, and yellow, the rose is the perfect gift for that special someone in your life. Even if that special someone is you!



Roses require special watering. When it is cooler they like a deep watering every 5 to 7 days. When it is hot they like consistent watering every day. Their roots are deep so you may not see signs of wilting. To avoid mildew, do not overhead water. Keep leaves and flowers dry.



Place in a location with at least 6 hours of direct sunlight per day. Morning sun is OK.



Roses prefer a liquid fertilizer. We recommend watering first then adding the fertilizer and then watering a little more so the fertilizer reaches the roots. You can find liquid rose fertilizers at any garden center.



Roses prefer a well draining soil and benefit from Mulching in the early Spring every year.



Roses are perennials and can be kept outside all year round. However, they do need protection from freezing so move them inside or insulate the roots over winter.
